General Information

- Red Deer Skating Club Members will have priority registration until September 19th, 2011.
- Out of town skaters will be accepted after this date based on availability of space.
- There will be **NO** registrations accepted by phone. Please be sure your registration reaches the administrator prior to the deadline.
- Registrations are accepted on a “first come” basis. Consider your requests as accepted. If you do not fit into a session, you will be notified by the administrator.
- No confirmations will be sent out.
- Complete the registration form and calendar in full, highlighting or circling the sessions you require.
- If you wish to make changes to your skating times after you have sent in your registration form, you **MUST** call the administrator. A list will be posted with all skaters who are registered on a session.
- Please register only for the sessions you are planning on skating as ice is in high demand.
- ALL SESSIONS ARE LIMITED TO 24 SKATERS.

The Red Deer Skating Club reserves the right to cancel or change all scheduled times and programs due to insufficient registration. Throughout the skating season, unexpected ice cancellations will occur. There will be no refunds for a change in the ice schedule.

Guidelines for Red Deer Club Members

- Red Deer Skating Club Members are required to skate a minimum of 3 hours per week.
- Red Deer Skating Club Members **MUST** register for one early school morning each week unless you are 7 years or younger on December 31, 2010.

Skating Session and Levels

- Monday to Friday sessions are at the Kinsmen Arenas, 5 McIntosh Ave, Red Deer, AB
- Saturday sessions are at the Collicutt Arena, 3030 30 Ave, Red Deer, AB
- All sessions are booked by level only. Skaters may do freeskate, skills, or dance on their session. Hours are calculated by the length of the session, not the amount of time your skater will be skating in that session.
- **JUNIOR SKATERS** are skaters who are working on their Preliminary Freeskate or working on their Junior Bronze Freeskate and have not passed any competitive tests.
- **INTERMEDIATE SKATERS** are skaters who have passed their Preliminary Freeskate and are working on their Junior Bronze Freeskate or have passed their Sr. Bronze Freeskate or Juvenile Competitive test.
- **SENIOR SKATERS** are skaters working on their Junior Silver Freeskate and higher or have passed their Pre-Novice Competitive test or higher.
- **PRESTARSKATE SKATERS** are Junior Skaters working in a group lesson.

Refund/Cancellation Policy

Refunds will be considered on a half season basis. You must contact the administrator if you are not going to be skating for an extended period (6 weeks or more) and wish a refund. 20% of total registration fee will be retained for any cancellation except for injury & with a Dr's certificate. No refunds except with a Dr's certificate.

Drop In Ice

Skaters are welcome to pick up ice on a drop-in basis as long as the session is not full. A sign up sheet will be posted at the rink, please check that the session you are wanting to skate on is not already full. Please sign up BEFORE you go onto the ice. A minimum of a ½ hour will be posted to your account. Cost is \$13.00 per hour for members and \$15.00 per hour for non-members plus a one-time administration fee of \$25.00 (admin fee for non-members only).

Music

The music will be played from the boards at the penalty box during Winter School. The coaches and senior skaters will handle putting on their own music, but parents are required to help with the Junior and Intermediate sessions. There will be a sign up sheet posted at the rink for parents to help out.

Christmas & New Year's Ice

The Christmas and New Year's break will be from December 23, 2011 to January 8th, 2012. Regular winter ice will commence on Monday January 9th, 2012. During the break there will be some extra ice available for all skaters. A sign up sheet will be posted on the bulletin board in December.

Associate Members

Associate members are skaters who are registered in another club and wish to skate in Red Deer on a weekly basis for additional practice or coaching purposes. They will be accepted as space permits after September 19th, 2011. The cost for an Associate Member is \$215.00 per hour for the season. Associate members must contact the administrator before they begin skating.

Giftmas Raffle

Each Red Deer Skating Club skater is required to purchase a minimum of 1 book of 5 tickets for \$25.00 for our annual giftmas raffle. Tickets will be distributed the first week of winter school. Draw will take place at our charity Christmas skate on Sunday December 19th. Additional tickets will be for sale while quantities last. Tickets are \$5.00 each.

Test Days

Due to the shortage of evaluators available to us, any test days we have will be held during normal skating hours. There will be no refunds for any sessions missed due the test day.

Ice Etiquette

What is etiquette? Etiquette is any special code of behavior or courtesy. At any level of skating, it is important that skaters follow a few basic rules to keep everyone safe and allow each skating session to be enjoyable and productive. Here are a few rules of etiquette to follow while on the ice...

- ✓ Be aware of the skaters around you. You are out on the ice for enjoyment, however, being “heads-up” and paying attention to all the other skaters will make it easier to all to have fun and learn.
- ✓ Be polite. You may say “excuse-me” to a fellow skater while you are trying to do your element (jump, spin, skill, and dance). Yelling on the ice is inappropriate.
- ✓ No profanity! This includes the music being played. If foul language is heard, skaters will be asked to leave the ice and/or music will be removed.
- ✓ No talking in the middle of the ice. It is unsafe for all skaters to be talking in the middle of the ice surface, please move to the side boards if you wish to have a discussion.
- ✓ Who has the right of way? A skater doing their solo. All skater’s should be aware of each other’s music. Every skater should be able to get through their program successfully without having to miss any elements. A skater who is in a lesson (skills, freeskate, or dance) has the second right of way. When the session ends, the zamboni has the right of way and ALL SKATERS and COACHES must exit the ice when the session is over.
- ✓ Fill holes in the ice before you leave the ice. All skaters must help fill the holes at the end of the session.
- ✓ The club administrator and/or the coaches have the right to place skaters on another session due to membership situations, the skater’s competitive record, technical level and skater’s work ethic.
- ✓ The Red Deer Skating Club encourages a positive environment to be displayed by ALL, including parents in the stands and lobby, coaches and skaters. Please set a good example for our club.
- ✓ Skaters who skate sessions without paying or registering will be asked to leave the ice surface until payments are received. NO QUESTIONS ASKED!

Basic Ice: \$600.00 for the first 3 hours per week for the season (These fees cover coaches stroking fees, test day expenses, and administration costs)

Additional Ice: \$102.00 per hour for the season

Skate Canada: \$33.00
Red Deer Skating Club members only. Cannot be paid using Bingo funds.

Associate Member: \$215.00 per hour for the season
