Procedures and Etiquette

The following is a list of procedures and etiquette guidelines that the Red Deer Skating Club would like to share with you to help the summer skating school ice sessions run smoother.

- 1. The skater who is skating to his/her solo, skating skills, or dance music has the right of way. This skater has the right of way over all coaches and skaters, including those in a lesson.
- 2. No profanity, this includes music too!
- 3. Be courteous when playing your solo by not playing it back to back if there is a line up waiting.
- 4. To help the traffic move better on the ice and keep everyone safe, please consider the following:
 - Coach from the boards when possible
 - Look both ways for traffic before stepping away from the boards and crossing the ice.
 - Help skaters know whose solo is playing and remind them they need to watch out for that skater.
 - Watch out for skaters entering a jump, especially when in a lutz corner.
- 5. The City of Red Deer requests that all skaters patch the ice before getting off.
- 6. Please clean-up after yourself in the dressing room.



Off Ice Info

Off Ice is a program developed to help enhance the necessary skills required for Figure Skating such as: flexibility, balance, endurance, rhythm, strength and jump technique. The Schedule will be posted on the bulletin board but will be on Tuesdays, Wednesday and Thursdays. It will be held at the Collicutt at 1:15PM. The

cost is covered in the fees for your ice sessions. If you are not registered for that week of skating then the cost is \$5.00 per session. EVERYONE is welcome!!! Meet in the arena lobby. We have planned: Dance Magic for dance classes, stretch class, jump technique and more.

Drop In Ice

Drop In ice is available on any session that does not have more than 24 skaters. The sign up sheet will be on the bulletin board. Drop In ice is \$20.00 per hour. For non-registered skaters, the drop in fee is \$22.00 per hour plus a one-time \$25.00 admin fee. If you would like to clear up your account you can pay Patti the fees owing before the last day of summer skating.
