3. Registration

Registration **opens** Monday October 2nd @ 8am MST.

If you would like to send a wish to your shining STAR, place your good luck announcement in the Fun On Ice program! For \$5 at time of registration you will be able to add a (max 15 word) message to your skater!

Add your wish to your cart before check-out while registering your skater.

4. **Closing Date Of Entries**

All entries must be received **NO LATER** than November 9, 2023 12pm (noon) MST. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that their entry is submitted through the online registration system by the closing date. All assessment requirements must be passed by the closing date of entries.

5. **Event Schedule**

Will be posted on the club website: **skatereddeer.com**

Schedule of events will also be emailed to each participant.

6. **Refund Of Entry Fees**

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held. There will be no refunds given for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

7. **Music**

Music must be turned in at the time of registration. **Two copies of the participants music must be registered.** Music must be on CD's, and each CD must have only one program on it. Skaters are responsible for the recovery of their own music at the completion of the event.

8. **On-Site Registration**

Skaters must register at least one hour prior to the start of their scheduled event.

Skaters must report to the Ice Captain one hour prior to their scheduled category.

9. **Marking System**

STAR 1-3 will be judged as per the STAR Event Management Guide.

10. **Awards**

Skaters will receive a Gold, Silver or Bronze medal. It is the responsibility of skaters to wear their skates & skating attire for the medal presentations

11. **Evaluators**

The event is being held under the current rules of Skate Alberta and the Star 1-3 Inter-Club Competition guidelines.

12. **Event Specifications**

In normal circumstances, each category offered at the competition will be held for men and women separately. The decision to combine categories is at the discretion of the Lead Judge and the Host Committee. Categories may be combined, due to low entries for either age categories or combined male/female events.

13. **Warm Up Times**

Skate Canada has standardised warm up times for all events.

14. **Accidents**

The Association and Committee of the Host Club undertake no responsibility for damages or injuries suffered by the skater. As a condition of and in consideration of their entries in this event, all competitors and their parents or guardians shall be deemed to agree to assume all risks or injuries to the competitor's person and property resulting from, or caused by, or connected with the conduct and management of the competitions. An agreement must Also be deemed to release any and call claims they may have against the Officials, the Association, the Host Club, and their officers. Entries shall be Only in accordance with these conditions.

15. **Pictures & Video**

Persons wishing to take photographs of on ice performances are reminded that the use of flash cameras is NOT permitted. The use of video cameras must be restricted to areas that do not hamper the skaters or officials.

NOTE: You may ONLY take photos or videos of your own skater.
