The Red Deer Skating Club's PreSTARskate is an introductory program designed to teach the elements of figure skating. When ready, your skater can move to STARskate which offers opportunities for skaters to develop skills in the areas of ice dance, skating skills, freeskate, and interpretive skating. The PreStar program teaches figure skating skills in a group lesson format in a progressive and sequential manner and includes specifically designed awards and incentives.
