#### General Information

- There will be NO registrations accepted by phone. Register at: www.skatereddeer.com
- If you wish to make changes to your skating times after you have registered please call the Administrator.
- Please note: a \$50.00 late registration fee will be automatically be applied to your account after
- The Executive has chosen **NOT** to raise the cost of skating this season and use the money earned from the Casino to pay the 3% increase in ice fees.
- The Club requests that each family sell a minimum of one book of raffle tickets.
- Session fees cover: stroking fees, ice fees, off ice fees (NEW), Skate Canada membership fee and administration costs.

\*\*\*The Red Deer Skating Club reserves the right to cancel or change all scheduled times and programs. Throughout the skating season, unexpected ice cancellations will occur. There will be no refunds.

#### **Fees**

**Minimum Package:** \$600.00 for 2 sessions per week for the season. **Basic Package:** \$750.00 for 3 sessions per week for the season.

**Additional Ice:** \$125.00 for all extra sessions purchased after your 3<sup>rd</sup> session for the entire season.

**Associate Member:** \$300.00 for one hour each week for the entire season. (Please contact the Administrator)

#### **Skating Session and Levels**

- Monday to Friday sessions are at the Kinsmen Arenas: 5 McIntosh Ave, Red Deer, AB Skaters may do freeskate, skills, or dance on their session.
- **JUNIOR SKATERS** are skaters who are working on their Preliminary Freeskate or working on their Junior Bronze Freeskate tests.
- INTERMEDIATE SKATERS are skaters who have passed their Preliminary Freeskate and are working on their Junior Bronze Freeskate or Sr. Bronze Freeskate test.
- **SENIOR SKATERS** are skaters working on their Senior Bronze Freeskate test.
- **PRESTARSKATE SKATERS** are Junior Skaters working in a group lesson.

#### Refund/Cancellation Policy

Refunds will be considered on a half season basis. You must contact the administrator if you are not going to be skating for an extended period (6 weeks or more) and wish a refund. 20% of total registration fee will be retained for any cancellation except for injury & with a Dr's certificate. No refunds except with a Dr's certificate.

#### Drop In Ice

Skaters are welcome to pick up ice on a drop-in basis as long as the session is not full. A sign-up sheet will be posted at the rink, please check that the session you want to skate on is not already full. Please sign up BEFORE you go onto the ice. A minimum of a ½ hour will be posted to your account. Cost is \$16.00 per hour for members and \$21.00 per hour for non-members.

#### **Associate Members**

Associate members are skaters who are registered in another club and wish to skate in Red Deer on a weekly basis for additional practice or coaching purposes. The cost for an Associate Member is \$300.00 for each session purchased. You will get that session every week for the <a href="entire">entire</a> season. Associate members <a href="must">must</a> contact the administrator before they begin skating. DO NOT register on line for this program!

#### **Test Days**

Test days have been requested for December and March. There will be no refunds for any sessions missed due the test day.

#### Off Ice

Off Ice (dryland training) will be offered on Saturdays twice per month from 1230-130PM at the Collicutt Center. The cost of this program will be covered in your registration fees and will be offered free to all Starskater's. There may be special events offered that will require extra fees.

#### **Volunteer Commitment**
