#### **General Information**

- There will be **NO** registrations accepted by phone. Register at: **www.skatereddeer.com**
- If you wish to make changes to your skating times after you have registered please call the Administrator.
- Please note: a **\$50.00 late registration fee** will be automatically applied to your account after September 20th.
- The Club does not have any fundraising requirements at this time.
- Session fees cover: Stroking, Ice Fees, Dryland Programs, Skate Canada Membership, Sport Psychology Classes and Admin costs.

#### \*\*\*The Red Deer Skating Club reserves the right to cancel or change all scheduled times and programs. Throughout the skating season, unexpected ice cancellations will occur. There will be no refunds.

#### <u>Fees</u>

Minimum Package: \$600.00 for 2 sessions per week for the season.
Basic Package: \$750.00 for 3 sessions per week for the season.
Additional Ice: \$125.00 for all extra sessions purchased after your 3<sup>rd</sup> session for the entire season.
Associate Member: \$300.00 for one hour each week for the entire season. (Please contact the Administrator)

#### Skating Session and Levels

- Monday to Friday sessions are at the Kinsmen Arenas: 5 McIntosh Ave, Red Deer, AB Skaters may do freeskate, skills, or dance on their session.
- **JUNIOR SKATERS** are skaters who are working on their Star 1 to 3 Freeskate Tests. And have completed the Prestarskate program and have private lesson coach.
- **INTERMEDIATE SKATERS** are skaters who are working on their Star 4 to 6 Freeskate test.
- SENIOR SKATERS are skaters working on their Star 7-10 Freeskate test.
- **PRESTARSKATE SKATERS** are skaters working in the Prestar group with a private lesson coach.

## **<u>Refund/Cancellation Policy</u>**

Refunds will be given only for medical reasons. A doctor's certificate is required for submission to the administrator for reimbursement. Reimbursement will be on a prorated basis. A 20% registration charge will be withheld on all refunds.

#### <u>Drop In Ice</u>

Skaters are welcome to pick up ice on a drop-in basis as long as the session is not full. A sign-up sheet will be posted at the rink, please check that the session you want to skate on is not already full. Please sign up BEFORE you go onto the ice. A minimum of a  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour will be posted to your account. Cost is \$16.00 per hour for members and \$21.00 per hour for non-members.

#### Make Up Ice (REVISED)

A skater may make up a session they missed on another day. To do this you must email the Club Administrator to notify the club of the change and CC your Coach on the email, prior to skating on the session. The session you are switching to must not be full. It needs to be noted that you are a guest on that session. All sessions must be made up within the season that they were missed. Ie: winter sessions can only be made up during the winter season. Subject to club approval. **NO** MAKE UP ice allowed for ice missed due to: Stat Holidays, test days, simulation, carnival or any club planned activities. If you miss due to a family holiday there is **NO** MAKE UP sessions.

#### Associate Members

Associate members are skaters who are registered in another club and wish to skate in Red Deer on a weekly basis for additional practice or coaching purposes. The cost for an Associate Member is \$300.00 for each session purchased. You will get that session every week for the <u>entire</u> season. Associate members <u>must</u> contact the administrator before they begin skating. <u>DO NOT</u> register on-line for this program!

#### <u>Test Days</u>

Test days have been requested for December and March. There will be no refunds for any sessions missed due the test day and no make up ice for these missed sessions.

#### Dryland Training

**FLEX** class (dryland training) will be offered to all Intermediate and Senior Starskaters. The cost of this program will be covered in your registration fees and will be offered for free. The classes will be at Annie L. Gaetz School Tuesdays and Thursdays from 700-800pm. Please bring a yoga mat and runners. Please add class to your cart. **FIT** class (dryland training) will be offered to all Prestarskaters and Junior Starskaters. The cost of this program will be covered in your registration fees and will be offered for free. The classes will be at Annie L. Gaetz School Tuesdays and Thursdays from 6-645pm. Please bring a yoga mat and runners. Please add the class to your cart.

#### Psyched 2 Perform

These classes will be offered for free to club members, two Wednesdays a month from 745-845pm in the upstairs meeting room at the Kinsmen Arena. It's for Starskaters ages 11 and up. They will learn about focus, positive self-talk and how to train.

#### <u>Train The Brain</u>

These classes will be offered for free to club members, one Wednesday a month at 615-715pm in the upstairs meeting room at the Kinsmen Arena. It's for Prestarskaters and Starskaters ages 5-10. They will learn about focus, positive self-talk and how to train.
