- If you wish to make changes to your skating times after you have registered please call the Administrator.
- Please note: a **\$50.00 late registration fee** will be automatically applied to your account after Sept 15th.
- The Club does not have any fundraising requirements at this time.
- Session fees cover: Stroking, Ice Fees, Dryland Programs, Skate Canada Membership, Sport Psychology Classes and Admin costs.
- Please carefully read the club policies and become familiar with them.
- Due to **Covid-19** the club will be monitoring and restricting regulations as per AHS, Skate Alberta, and the City of Red Deer and are subject to change as deemed necessary by the Red Deer Skating Club.
- You will be required to declare the activities that you are participating in this winter.

***The Red Deer Skating Club reserves the right to cancel or change all scheduled times and programs. Throughout the skating season, unexpected ice cancellations will occur. There will be no refunds.

<u>Fees</u>

Minimum Package: \$600.00 for 2 sessions per week for the season.

Basic Package: \$750.00 for 3 sessions per week for the season.

Additional Ice: \$125.00 for all extra sessions purchased after your 3rd session for the entire season.

Associate Member: \$300.00 for one hour each week for the entire season. Please contact the Administrator first. ***You may select to make installment payments each month at the time of check out.

Skating Session and Levels

- Monday to Friday sessions are at the Kinsmen Arenas: 5 McIntosh Ave, Red Deer, AB Skaters may do freeskate, skills, or dance on their session.
- **PRESTARSKATE SKATERS** are skaters working in the Prestar group with a private lesson coach. To be able to skate on a starskate session these skaters must have passed two star tests and be on approved session.
- **JUNIOR SKATERS** are skaters who are working on their Star 1 to 3 **Freeskate** Tests, have completed the Prestarskate program and have a private lesson coach.
- **INTERMEDIATE SKATERS** are skaters who are working on their Star 4 to 6 Freeskate test.
- SENIOR SKATERS are skaters working on their Star 7- Gold Freeskate test.

<u>Refund/Cancellation Policy</u>

Refunds will be given only for medical reasons. A doctor's certificate is required for submission to the administrator for reimbursement. Reimbursement will be on a prorated basis. A 20% registration charge will be withheld on all refunds.

Drop-In Ice (REVISED)

Skaters are welcome to pick up ice on a drop-in basis as long as the session is not full. You must email the Administrator 24 hours before the session you wish to drop in on. Your name must be on the log in and screening list. Cost is \$16.00 per hour.

Make-Up Ice (REVISED)

There is NO MAKE-UP ICE this season.

Associate Members

Associate members are skaters who are registered in another club and wish to skate in Red Deer on a weekly basis for additional practice or coaching purposes. The cost for an Associate Member is \$300.00 for each session purchased. You will get that session every week for the <u>entire</u> season. Associate members <u>must</u> contact the administrator before they begin skating. <u>DO NOT</u> register on-line for this program!

Assessment Days

Test days have been requested for December and March. There will be no refunds for any sessions missed due to the test day and no make up ice for these missed sessions. We are not approved for Assessment Days at this time.

Dryland Training

FLEX class (dryland training) will be offered to all Intermediate and Senior Starskaters. The cost of this program will be covered in your registration fees. The classes will be held on Zoom on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 645-745pm. Please add class to your cart.
