- Session fees cover: Stroking, Ice Fees, Dryland Programs, Skate Canada Membership, Human Performance Classes, Testing Ice Fees, Simulation Ice Fees and Admin costs.

- **The Red Deer Skating Club reserves the right to cancel or change all scheduled times and programs. Throughout the skating season, unexpected ice cancellations will occur. There will be no refunds. There is NO make up ice.**

Fees

Minimum Package: \$600.00 for 2 sessions per week for the season.

Basic Package: \$750.00 for 3 sessions per week for the season.

Additional Ice: \$125.00 for all extra sessions purchased after your 3rd session for the entire season.

Associate Member: \$350.00 for one hour each week for the entire season. Please contact the Administrator first.

***Full time Club members may select to make installment payments each month at the time of check out.

Skating Session and Levels

- Monday to Friday sessions are at the Kinsmen Arenas: 5 McIntosh Avenue and Friday daytime sessions are at the Collicutt Center 3031 30th Avenue. Skaters may do freeskate, skills, or dance on their session.
- **PRESTARSKATE SKATERS** are skaters working in the Prestar group. To be able to skate on session 14 these skaters must have a private lesson coach and must have passed two star tests.
- A skaters skating level is based on the highest freeskate test passed.

Refund/Cancellation Policy

Refunds will be given only for medical reasons. A doctor's certificate is required for submission to the administrator for reimbursement. Reimbursement will be on a prorated basis. A 20% registration charge will be withheld on all refunds. Skaters must have missed a minimum of 21 days of skating to qualify. Once your skater returns to the ice in ANY capacity full fees will be reinstated.

Make-Up

There is NO MAKE-UP ICE.

Drop-In Ice

Skaters are welcome to pick up ice on a drop-in basis as long as the session is not full. You must be a registered member of the winter season. Please email the Administrator and your coach 24 hours before the session you wish to drop in on. Cost is \$20.00 per hour.

Associate Members

Associate members are skaters who are registered in another club and wish to skate in Red Deer on a weekly basis for additional practice or coaching purposes. The cost for an Associate Member is \$350.00 for each session purchased. You will get that session every week for the entire season. Associate members **must** contact the administrator before they begin skating. **DO NOT** register on-line for this program!

Assessment Days

Assessment days and times to be announced. There will be no refunds for any sessions missed due to the assessments and no make-up ice for these missed sessions.

Dryland Training

PRESTAR & FIT Class (dryland training) will be offered to all Prestarskaters and Junior Starskaters on Monday 515-615pm.

FIT & FLEX Class will be offered: Monday 630-730pm, Tuesday 545-645pm and 7-8pm, Thursday 7-8pm. This class is for all Starskaters.

The cost of these programs are covered in your registration fees. The classes will be held in the upstairs Studio. Please add the class to your cart.

Human Performance

TRAIN THE BRAIN

These classes will be offered to club members, one Wednesday a month at 515-6pm. This class is for Prestars and Junior Starskaters. The cost of this program will be covered in your registration fees. The classes will be held in the upstairs Dryland Training Room. Please add the class to your cart. They will learn about focus, positive self-talk and how to train.
